Kindergarten Program — Mrs. Yakimyshyn Mark

- Students must be 5 years of age or older on or before December 31st of the current school year to register (Exceptions: Late 2019 birthdates)
- Half-day program
- 4 classes – 2 morning programs and 2 afternoon programs
- Classes run on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday; no classes on Thursday
- Staggered entry in September to begin the school year
- Yellow bussing available (check with office – 780-409-2606)

Student Supports... - Mrs. Yakimyshyn Mark

- Instructional Coach
- EBS (Emotional Behavioural Specialist)
- EAL liaison (teacher)
- Therapeutic Assistant – Behavioural Therapy (TA-BT) x 4
- Educational Assistants (EA) x 11
- Speech and Language Pathologist comes on site monthly

School Fees* - Ms. Pedersen

Kindergarten

- \$30 Includes activities, events and a learning portfolio)
- field trips (Up to an additional \$75)

***All fees collected on a cost recovery basis**

Registration Information – K to 9 – Ms. Pedersen

- Accepting **RESIDENT** students within our **CATCHMENT AREA**
 - **RESIDENT STUDENT** – defined as student who is baptized Catholic, or a parent is baptized Catholic
 - **CATCHMENT AREA** – South of Anthony Henday Drive and East of 66 Street
- Students who are not within our catchment area and/or who are not Catholic, may be placed on a waiting list
 - Families in this situation are encouraged to also pursue registration at their community school (Catholic) or EPSB
- Students currently registered at another Edmonton Catholic School (including 100 Voices) are NOT required to complete a new registration – please contact the office at 780-409-2606; still must meet requirements of being resident student in catchment area
