Recognition or Recall of:		Locate, Identify or Recall from Memory:

1.4	COMPARISONS	Likeness or differences among characters, times, place.
1.5	CAUSE AND EFFECT RELATIONSHIPS	Reasons for incidents, events, or character actions.
1.6	CHARACTER TRAITS	Find statements that tell what type of a character a person was.
